



Western Canada Summer Games 2011 Team Trials Information Package

Event Information

1. This competition will be used to determine nominations for membership on the 2011 Western Canada Summer Games Canoe/Kayak Team.
2. The date of the trial is Saturday June 18th, 2011.
3. The venue will be Wascana Lake in Regina.

Competition Specifics

1. All races will be competed in single boats.
2. The format will include individual starts for the 200m and 1000m races. Based on the results of the individual starts, the fastest nine athletes will be seeded into a 9 boat final. If there are 9 or less athletes entered in these events, there will be no individual starts and the event will go straight to a final. The 2000m races will be a mass start.

Points will be awarded for the placing in each race as follows:

1 st place:	10 points
2 nd place:	8 points
3 rd place:	7 points
4 th place:	6 points
5 th place:	5 points
6 th place:	4 points
7 th place:	3 points
8 th place:	2 points
9 th place:	1 point

Points from the best two races will be added to determine the individual ranking.

3. The nominations to the core team will be based on the Canoe Kayak Saskatchewan's 2011 Western Canada Summer Games Selection Criteria.
4. The competition is open to all High Performance athletes:
 - a. whose permanent residence is located in Saskatchewan for at least 180 days prior to the trials
 - b. who will be under 19 years of age as of January 1st, 2011
 - c. who have not competed at a world championship. Those who are attending national team selection events in order to gain a spot on the junior world team are welcome to compete in the Western Canada Summer Games selection event. If athletes selected to the Western Canada Summer Games Team become ineligible due to commitments with the national team the next highest ranked athlete will be named to the Western Canada Summer Games team.

5. In order to be eligible to compete, all entrants must be a member in good standing with the Sprint Division of Canoe Kayak Saskatchewan.
6. In order to be eligible to compete, all entrants must complete and submit a Registration Form, the Coach/Athlete Agreement and a Participant's Agreement. Please note that if the athlete is under the age of 18 their legal guardian must also sign these forms.
7. A final schedule will be produced after receipt of entries. The preliminary program is as follows:

Men & Women	1000m	Heats, Finals	K-1, C-1
Men & Women	200m	Heats, Finals	K-1, C-1
Men & Women	2000m	Final	K-1, C-1
Men & Women	500m	Race Offs (if needed)	K-1, C-1

The High Performance Committee reserves the right to change the published race schedules and the advancement format to provide the fairest possible racing conditions to all participating athletes.

8. The competition will be run with modified CKC Sprint racing rules.

Registration Details

1. The registration deadline for this competition is **Monday, June 13th, 2010 at 5:00 pm.** Completed registrations must be received at the Canoe Kayak Saskatchewan office by the deadline. Please submit your entry on time to avoid disappointment.
