SRCC began in 1985 in preparation for the 1989 Jeux Canada Summer Games in Saskatoon. The Boathouse is located on the North Saskatchewan River. Over the past 26 years we have had a history of producing many top national level athletes in Canada (two Olympians Jason Rusu-Barcelona 92, Corrina Kennedy – Atlanta 96, Shawn Mydan - 5x Senior World Championship athlete, and many National Team Juniors who raced at Jr. World Championships (Daniel Maksymiuk, Jenifer Adamson, Meghan McDonough, Jennifer Adamson, Trista Neilly, Shylo Wolff, Megan Gibson, Jarret Kenke). Our club was ranked 4th nationally in beginning of the 90s and stayed in the top 10 over a decade, recently top 15. We would like to strive to maintain our level and develop many top athletes by our club's coaches for next Jeux Canada Games.
